The Lord Howe Island Board is seeking Expressions of Interest from community members to join the **Community Environment Advisory Committee (CEAC)** for a two-year term. The CEAC provides strategic, non-binding advice to the LHIB on environmental management, biodiversity conservation, and biosecurity matters on Lord Howe Island.

The Committee includes five community representatives who volunteer their time to contribute local knowledge, diverse perspectives, and expertise to support the island's World Heritage values. Representatives also play a key role in fostering communication between the LHIB, residents, and other stakeholders, and in promoting sustainable environmental practices.

The CEAC meets quarterly, and members are expected to review documents, engage in strategic discussions, and provide input on matters such as the Biodiversity Management Plan, Permanent Park Preserve Plan of Management, and biosecurity strategies.
