Lord Howe Island is a World Heritage listed location. Over 75% of the island is designated as a permanent park preserve, surrounded by the Lord Howe Island Marine Park which includes the world's southernmost coral reef. The marine park is underpinned by the Marine Estate Management Act 2014, Marine Estate Management Regulation 2017 and the Marine Estate Management (Management Rules) Regulation 1999.

Effective environmental protection assists with achieving Lord Howe Island's overarching environmental vision of protecting the island's World Heritage values, biodiversity and threatened species.

On-island environmental goals and undertakings are underpinned by the LHI Biodiversity Management Plan and supported by legislation including the NSW Biosecurity Act 2015, and the Lord Howe Island Act 1953.

Please note:

- All reservations apply only to the dates listed, and may not be transferred to another vessel or person.
- We will try our best to keep you on one mooring but it may be necessary to move you during your stay.
- We assume no responsibility for damage to underwater appendages due to low water.
- In the unlikely event of your allocated mooring being unavailable or out of order due to unforeseen service needs, environmental issues, we reserve the right to cancel at any time without notice in the event of these special circumstances. In this case we will endeavour to find you a suitable alternative mooring or you will receive a full refund.

Cancellation policy:

- The administration fee for the Lord Howe Island Board to process each mooring booking application is <u>non-refundable</u>.
- Where you elect to cancel your booking, if the arrival date is greater than 28 days from the date of cancellation, a refund will be given for all fees charged except for the administration fee.
- Where you elect to cancel your booking 28 days or less before their arrival date, the booking is non-refundable, and no changes will be permitted.
- If you are unable to make your voyage due to unsuitable weather conditions your booking may be transferred to alternative dates, subject to their availability. In this instance a new approval letter with amended dates will need to be issued.

PRIVACY NOTICE

The Lord Howe Island Board (LHIB), of Bowker Avenue Lord Howe Island, is collecting your personal information. LHIB is subject to the Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998. Personal information means information or opinion about an individual whose identity is apparent or can be reasonably ascertained from the information or opinion.

The LHIB is collecting your personal information for the following purposes as relevant:

- 1. to assess if you meet the relevant requirements to be permitted to land your aircraft on Lord Howe Island.
- 2. to ensure that the biosecurity measures you have undertaken are suitable to ensure the protection of the Lord Howe Island environment and community.
- 3. for compliance and enforcement;
- 4. to obtain advice from professionals and/or NSW Department of Primary Industries (DPI) for the purposes of assessing your biosecurity measures
- 5. for safety purposes relating to your aircraft and passengers, and the associated safety and well-being of others on Lord Howe Island
- 6. for internal training or data analysis
- 7. to make contact with previous applicants to advise of updates or changes to the guidelines

For any of the above purposes, the LHIB may disclose your personal information to enforcement officers (including authorised officers and NSW Police), relevant health and safety organisations, DPI and relevant staff at the Department of Planning and Environment as and when required. The LHIB will not disclose your personal information to any other third party, unless you provide consent, or it is permitted, or required to do so under law.

The LHIB may only use your personal information in a way which is consistent with these purposes or in a way that is otherwise permitted under law.

You may provide the personal information of other people when you complete this form. Before you do so, you must obtain their consent to provide this information and for it to be used in accordance with this Privacy Notice.

Providing your personal information to LHIB is voluntary, as landing your aircraft on Lord Howe Island is voluntary. But failure to provide your personal information will mean that the LHIB will not be able to allow you to land your aircraft on Lord Howe Island.
