Hybrid renewable energy project

Planning is progressing well for the hybrid renewable energy system. The development application for the solar element of the project has been submitted and the referral application for the solar panels has been issued to the Federal Department of the Environment.

A second noise assessment is underway so we can compare winter background noise levels with the results from the first noise assessment carried out last summer. The findings from the winter assessment will be available soon to give us a more detailed understanding of the potential noise impacts from the wind turbines.

We will be running a visitor survey during September and October to find out exactly what visitors think about the plans for Lord Howe Island's renewable energy future. Please encourage visitors to complete the survey at the airport before they leave.

Come along to the Community Markets at the school on **Sunday 13 September** from 10.30am. Mel and Dave from Jacobs will be on the Island to launch the visitor survey and talk more about the renewable energy project in general.
