

Lord Howe Island Board 2021 Election of Four (4) Members to the Board

Enrolment Notice

Pursuant to section 9A(b) of the Lord Howe Island Act 1953 No. 39, the Electoral Commissioner for New South Wales shall conduct an election for the purpose of determining the Islanders to be elected to the Lord Howe Island Board pursuant to section 4(3)(a) of the Act.

Electors

A person enrolled on the State electoral roll for the electorate in which the Island is situated is entitled to be enrolled as an elector for the Lord Howe Island Board election if the person is resident on the Island and the person's address on that electoral roll is an address on the Island.

Enrolment for the election closes Friday 15 January 2021

Persons eligible to be enrolled as electors on Lord Howe Island, are reminded that completed *Enrolment Forms* must be submitted to the Australian Electoral Commission by no later than Friday 15 January 2021.

Nominations

Advertisements inviting nominations for the four (4) positions on the Board will be placed on the Notice Boards on the Island on Friday 15 January 2021 and will also be published in the Government Gazette. To be eligible for nomination each candidate must be an Islander as defined in the Lord Howe Island Act 1953 and be enrolled as an elector for the election.

Nominations will open on Friday 15 January 2021 and will close at 12.00 noon, Friday 29 January 2021.
